In recent years it has become the custom of many congregations (as well as ours) to begin committee and board meetings with a blessing, “Blessed is the Eternal One our G-d sovereign of all, who sanctifies us through the mitzvot and has given us the mitzvah to serve the needs of the community.” After the prayer is spoken and a sense of higher purpose has been invoked, the participants turn to the hard work of addressing the various needs of the community. The blessing is uttered as the volunteer leaders are charged with oversight for the entire organization, holding a vision for the community, supporting programs and carrying the responsibility for fiscal well-being. The blessing is spoken with sincerity and calls on all to work together with a sense of higher and sacred purpose.

I am moved as I witness the dedication of our volunteers who have demanding jobs and family responsibilities. Yet somehow, they find the time to contribute their energy to building and maintaining our sacred community. Their service is a remarkable and generous gift from the heart. If you are not presently involved in volunteering, and you are able to do so, I urge you to be generously responsive in every way to their requests for your participation and invitations to support the community through giving your time and your financial resources when called upon. Better yet, don't wait to be called upon. Step forward and call our board and staff leadership and make known your willingness to do what you can to build this community. It is essential that we all understand that no one will build our community beside us – all of us together with the help of G-d. It is an error in thinking to consider membership in a sacred community as no more than a purchase of services. Sacred communities are built upon a covenantal sense of shared responsibility for shared values and not on a sense of a “fee-for-services” type of relationship.

To solidify this concept, I'd like to suggest that we incorporate a formal blessing in all of our future meetings. Here is an example one such blessing any and all committees may choose to recite at the beginning of their meeting:

Blessed you are, ETERNAL ONE, our God, Sovereign of the universe, who has consecrated us with Your mitzvot, and commanded us to occupy ourselves with the needs of the community.

As we move forward we have many challenges to meet but they are most certainly well worth meeting. May we each enjoy the sweet joy that comes from fulfilling the mitzvah, *La-asok B'tzorkhei Tzibur*, to serve the needs of our community.

Yom Ha´atzmaut – The Independence Day of Israel

David Ben-Gurion, who was the first prime minister of Israel, publicly read the Declaration of Independence of Israel on May 14, 1948. According to the Jewish calendar, this was the fifth day of Iyar, the eighth month of the civil year, in the year 5708. The anniversary of this date on the Jewish calendar is known as Yom Ha'atzmaut and usually falls in April or May of the Gregorian Calendar. This year, the Independence day will begin on the evening, April 14th.

The **Jewish War Veterans of the United States of America** is now celebrating its 125th Anniversary. **JWV** is the oldest veterans' organization in the United States and is chartered by the US Congress. Jews have served this country in every war since before the nation was founded. The JWV has many notable accomplishments throughout the years: lobbying for legislation to assist Jewish veterans, printing Jewish Bibles and sending them to Jewish servicemen serving abroad, establishing the National Museum of American Jewish Military History and the Fallen Heroes Memorial, to name only a few.

In 1999 Hernando County chartered the JWV Post 997. The post became inactive several years ago due to declining membership. There are a number of Jewish Veterans in the area who would like to see the post re-activated. Our newest TBD member, **Larry Jasper**, is the Commander of both JWV Post 373 in Tampa and the JWV Department of Florida. Larry would love to facilitate the re-activation of our chapter. Jewish War Veterans of the United States of America (JWV)

In August of 1999 Hernando County chartered JWV Post 997. The post has become inactive due to declining membership. There are a number of Jewish Veterans in the area who would like to see the post re-activated. If you are a Jewish Veteran and would like to consider becoming a part of JWV, please contact Larry Jasper by phone or email as above. Larry is currently a member of Temple Beth David, a resident of Spring Hill, and the Commander of both JWV Post 373 in Tampa and the JWV Department of Florida.

Some history of JWV:

Seeking recognition for service in the US Civil War, and to dispel the belief that Jews did not serve, on March 15, 1896, 63 Jewish Civil War Veterans gathered and formed the Hebrew Union Veterans (now JWV). Jews have served this Country in every conflict since before the US became a Nation.

JWV is now celebrating our 125th Anniversary. JWV is also the oldest veterans' organization in the United States and is chartered by the US Congress. (The American Legion was formed 3 years later)

Some notable accomplishments of JWV:

- 1912: Secured passage of legislation removing restrictions against Jews serving in the New York State National Guard.
- 1917: Helped form the Jewish Welfare Board (JWB).
- 1927: Successfully lobbied for legislation requiring the American Battlefield Monument Commission to place Star of David Markers on the graves of Jewish soldiers buried in war cemeteries in France.
- 1948: Proudly accepted the transfer of JWB's responsibility to process claims for veterans and assist them in securing benefits.
- 1955: Signed an accord with the Association of Jewish Chaplains that provided for consultation and cooperation by both organizations on matters relating to religious activities in the military and veteran affairs.
- 1958: Founded the National Museum of American Jewish Military History in Washington D.C. to document and preserve the contributions of [Jewish Americans](#) to the peace and freedom of the United States and to educate the public concerning the courage, heroism and sacrifices made by Jewish Americans who served in the [armed forces](#). Admission is free.
- 1977: JWV contributed \$275,000 to build a Jewish chapel at West Point.
- 1991: JWV rushed a special printing of pocket-sized Jewish bibles and airlifted them to Jewish personnel in the Gulf War.
- 2006: Established The Fallen Heroes Memorial, an ongoing record of all Jewish American servicemembers lost since 9/11.






